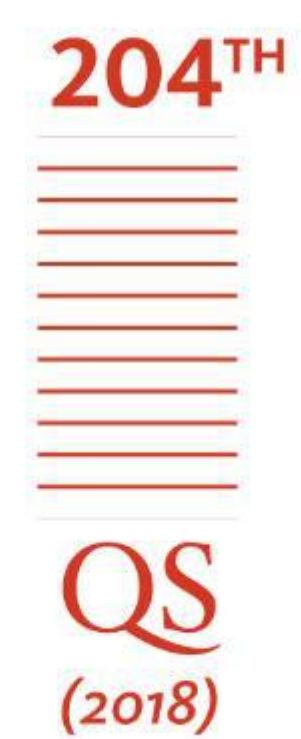

Previous education

- The Indian School Certificate (from the CISCE, only academic stream after 12 years of education, Standard XII), if 5 subjects have been passed with an average of at least 75%
- The All India Senior School Certificate (from the CBSE, only academic stream after 12 years of education, Standard XII), if 5 subjects have been passed with the grades A1, A2 or B1.
- Diplomas will be assessed individually

Language requirements

- IELTS Academic: minimum overall score: 6.0
- TOEFL iBT: minimum overall score: 80
- Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English (CAE): minimum C

- In the same area of studies as your previous education
- General/ Honours Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Science
